## WORKING ASSET

## AUTHORITY GOAL

Make the clinic easier to trust before treatment planning begins by improving consult answers, emotional guidance, and partner-ready public authority.

## **ASSET DEPLOYMENT PLAN**

1. Publish the fertility answer map on high-intent consult and FAQ surfaces.
2. Install the journey guide to support emotional trust and partner clarity.
3. Reuse the clinic answerworthiness playbook on broader answer surfaces.
4. Tighten booking readiness before the first consult.
5. Expand the strongest answer blocks into AI-readable and local trust surfaces.

## **30-DAY ROLLOUT**

### **DAYS 1-10**

- publish the highest-friction consult answers
- rewrite one first-visit expectations block
- tag the most repeated patient and partner questions

### **DAYS 11-20**

- deploy the journey guide into coordinator and follow-up surfaces
- refresh one FAQ and one local trust section
- route one stronger proof cue into the consult path

### **DAYS 21-30**

- review which answers reduced confusion most
- tighten any weak partner-guidance or timing sections
- expand the best-performing blocks to wider public surfaces

## **TEAM OWNERSHIP MAP**

- physician lead: validates treatment and timing language
- care coordinator: owns journey and next-step clarity
- office manager: keeps logistics and preparation guidance current
- marketing lead: routes answers and trust blocks across public surfaces

## **SUCCESS SIGNALS**

- fewer pre-consult clarification calls
- stronger consult readiness from both patients and partners
- clearer first-visit expectations

- better performance from public answers reused across pages and follow-up

### **HOW STRONG TEAMS ACTUALLY USE THIS ASSET**

- Assign one accountable owner instead of letting "Fertility Authority Kit" become shared but unmanaged work.
- Use it with fertility physicians, care coordinators, nurses, practice leaders, and marketers in a weekly rhythm so the asset drives decisions rather than sitting in a folder.
- Decide in advance what counts as green, watch, and red performance so the team knows when to escalate.
- Capture learnings directly in the document every week so the asset becomes smarter over time instead of resetting to zero.
