DEPLOYMENT NOTES

HOW STRONG TEAMS ACTUALLY USE THIS ASSET

- Assign one accountable owner instead of letting "HVAC Maintenance Reactivation Kit" become shared but unmanaged work.
- Use it with hvac owners, service managers, and office teams in a weekly rhythm so the asset drives decisions rather than sitting in a folder.
- Decide in advance what counts as green, watch, and red performance so the team knows when to escalate.
- Capture learnings directly in the document every week so the asset becomes smarter over time instead of resetting to zero.

30-DAY ROLLOUT SEQUENCE

- Reactivate overdue tune-up demand before peak season gets noisy.
- Score the current front door so reawakened demand does not leak.
- Tighten response speed and booking discipline across calls, forms, and texts.
- Use estimate follow-up structure to convert maintenance and replacement opportunities that stall.

WHAT SEPARATES A SERIOUS VERSION FROM A BASIC TEMPLATE

- Clear ownership for every step, not generic advice without accountability.
- Targets, thresholds, or decision rules that tell the team what good looks like.
