OPERATING GOAL

Install a more complete veterinary authority layer: calm first-touch intake, stronger new-client trust, better treatment follow-up, and more recommendation-ready public proof.

DEPLOYMENT ORDER

PHASE 1: FIRST-TOUCH CALM

- install the urgent-visit intake checklist
- tighten same-day and new-client routing

PHASE 2: HOUSEHOLD TRUST

- strengthen new-client public trust surfaces
- improve doctor, process, and review confidence

PHASE 3: POST-VISIT CONTINUITY

- install treatment-plan follow-up ownership
- track stalled recommendations and recovery

PHASE 4: PUBLIC PROOF MAINTENANCE

- refresh trust and review surfaces monthly

DEPLOYMENT NOTES

HOW STRONG TEAMS ACTUALLY USE THIS ASSET

- Assign one accountable owner instead of letting "Veterinary Authority Kit" become shared but unmanaged work.
- Use it with veterinarians, practice managers, csrs, treatment coordinators, and hospital operators in a weekly rhythm so the asset drives decisions rather than sitting in a folder.
- Decide in advance what counts as green, watch, and red performance so the team knows when to escalate.
- Capture learnings directly in the document every week so the asset becomes smarter over time instead of resetting to zero.

30-DAY ROLLOUT SEQUENCE

- Tighten first-touch intake so worried owners get a calmer, clearer next step immediately.
