## DEPLOYMENT NOTES

### HOW STRONG TEAMS ACTUALLY USE THIS ASSET

- Assign one accountable owner instead of letting "Veterinary Urgent Intake Kit" become shared but unmanaged work.
- Use it with veterinary owners, clinic managers, and front-desk teams in a weekly rhythm so the asset drives decisions rather than sitting in a folder.
- Decide in advance what counts as green, watch, and red performance so the team knows when to escalate.
- Capture learnings directly in the document every week so the asset becomes smarter over time instead of resetting to zero.

### 30-DAY ROLLOUT SEQUENCE

- Capture urgent pet calls with better intake and calmer triage.
- Tighten booking readiness so same-day demand is easier to route.
- Use reminders to reduce visit wobble and uncertainty.
- Keep reviews growing so trust compounds around the clinic.

### WHAT SEPARATES A SERIOUS VERSION FROM A BASIC TEMPLATE

- Clear ownership for every step, not generic advice without accountability.
- Targets, thresholds, or decision rules that tell the team what good looks like.
